Per DC regulations, back-up drinks include second drinks served as part of a "two-for-one" promotion, second drinks served just prior to last call and second drinks provided complimentary by the licensee or purchased by other patrons. Except as provided above, back-up drinks do not include two different drinks served together such as a beer and a shot or any other industry drink that can be considered a shot and a mixer.
